## CONVERSATIONS IN THE SPIRIT- DEANERY LISTENING SESSION

On Saturday the 9<sup>th</sup> of May, our Parish will be hosting a Deanery listening session for the upcoming Diocesan Synod.

The Diocesan Synod gathers religious, clergy and lay people for the purpose of reflecting on the needs of the Diocese, guided by the Holy Spirit. The Toowoomba Diocese 2026 Synod will focus on listening, sharing, and discerning practical and faithful ways to strengthen the mission of the Church within the Diocese.

The Synod will be held on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of October. In the lead up to Synod, it is important to hear from as many people in the diocese to ensure the whole community is considered and to identify a wide range of needs and concerns.

The listening session held in Warwick will consider the views from individuals in our deanery. We encourage all to come along so we may reflect on 'where the holy spirit is asking us to move as a community?'

The listening sessions will give a voice to the hopes and dreams for our Diocese and community.

The listening sessions have been designed to follow a process. The process is detailed below.

- The first stage; prepare and pray. On the day a stimulus will be provided to guide our conversation. A silence will follow before we share our thoughts in small groups.
- The second stage; prayerfully share. Each member will intentionally speak and listen graciously. Another silence will follow while we each reflect on what has been shared.
- The third stage; prayerfully respond. Members will consider what has been shared and may comment on what does and does not resonate.
- The fourth stage; discern movements of the Holy Spirit. Members will respond to 'are there any natural actions that could take place from what has emerged?'
- The last stage; pray. The final step will be to give thanks to God for all that was shared.

A more detailed step-by-step process labelled 'Conversations in the Spirit' has been created. Print outs have been left at each of church entrances.

We encourage everyone to attend a listening session. We are also open to holding other listening sessions.

If you have a group that would like to host a separate listening session, please contact the office.

If you are wanting to come to our listening session on May 9<sup>th</sup> and are unable to access the ticket portal, please pop into the office and we will assist you.

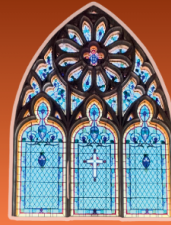

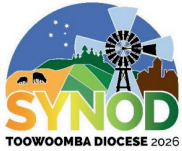
